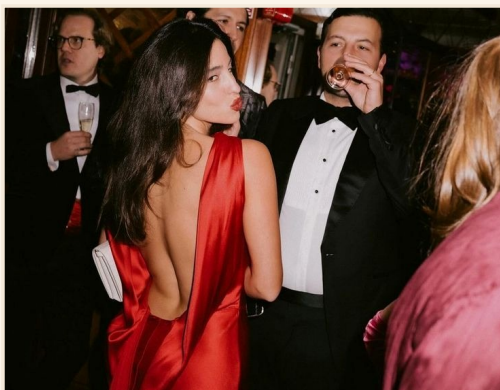
THE MOOD

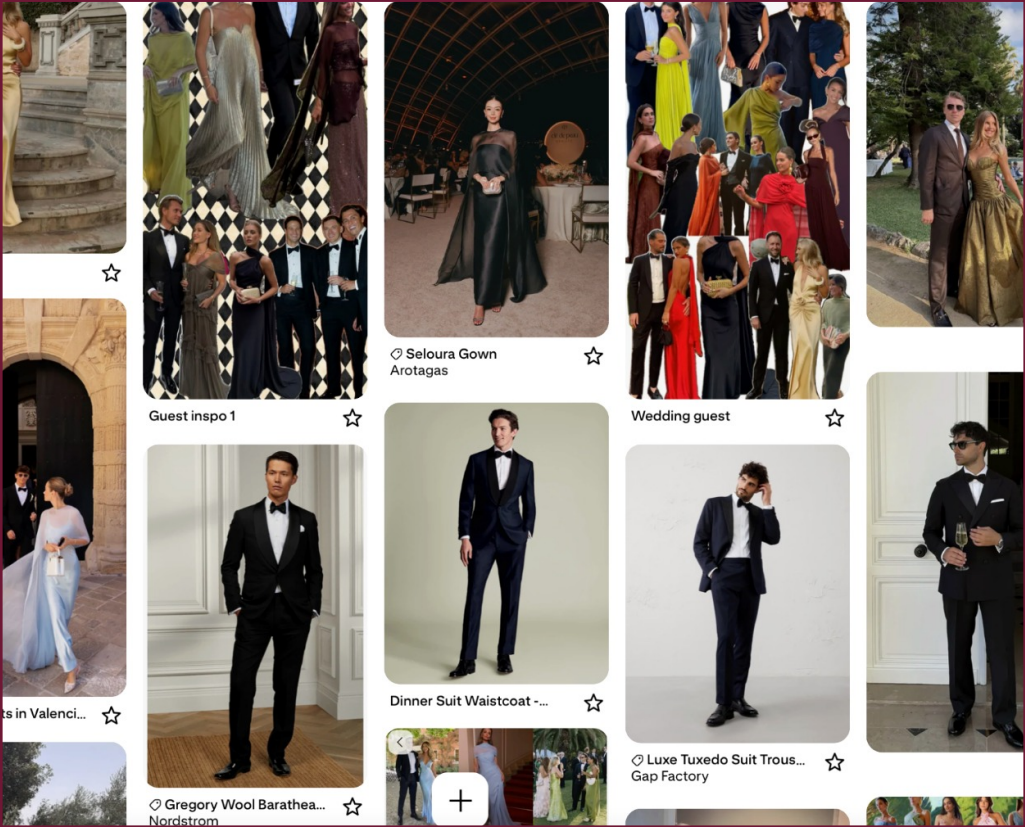
